The District/Authority Scholarships reward graduating students for excellence in their chosen non-academic field(s). Students who demonstrate superior achievement in any of the areas of Fine Arts, Applied Design and Skills, Physical Activity, International Languages, Indigenous Language and Culture, Community Service, and Technical and Trades Training are eligible to apply for these scholarships.

Successful recipients must fulfill graduation requirements by August 31st of their graduating year to be eligible for consideration of an award.

Students must be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident at the time of applying for the Dogwood District/Authority Award Scholarship.

The District/Authority Scholarship is valued at \$1250 and will be sent to the recipient in October, in the form of a voucher which can be redeemed upon proof of registration and attendance at a designated post-secondary institution or authorized trades training provider in BC, within five years of receipt.
