Applicants will be interviewed by a panel of School District #84 personnel: Superintendent, School Principal and Board of Education. These scholarships are open to any graduating student **provided that they have spent two secondary years in a School District #84 school.** The awards are dependent upon the graduating student attending a post-secondary institution for at least one year. The awards must be taken up within two years of graduation. **Terms of Reference:** As outlined in the Regulations and indicated on each application form, which can be found on the Gold River Secondary School website.

**SCHOOL DISTRICT #84 - CITIZENSHIP & SERVICE** **\$1000.00**  
Students should possess a record of actions in service, citizenship, and leadership undertaken in their school or community which contributes to making their community and/or school a more desirable place in a "people sense" and a physical sense.

**SCHOOL DISTRICT #84 - DISTRICT/AUTHORITY SCHOLARSHIP** **\$1250.00**  
There are five (5) District/Authority Scholarships available rewarding graduating students for excellence in their chosen fields of interest or strength. Students who demonstrate superior achievement in any of the areas of Fine Arts, Applied Skills, Physical Activity, International Languages, Community Service or Technical Trades Training are eligible to apply for these scholarships. Recipients must be a BC Resident and Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant), and be enrolled in School District 84, as well BC graduation requirements must be fulfilled by August 31<sup>st</sup> of their graduating year in order to be eligible for consideration of the award.
